



KAYAK RENTAL KIOSK

NEW LOCKER SYSTEM THAT HOUSES THE PPE AND PADDLES & A RACK SYSTEM



HOW IT WORKS



There is a locker system that houses the PPE and paddles, and then a rack system for the kayaks and/or paddle boards.

The customer agrees to all the liability waivers on the touch screen, selects the type watercraft they want (currently single or double kayaks or Paddle boards), selects how many hours they want to rent it for, and then swipes their credit card. The door to their PPE opens and the watercraft unlocks and away they go!

To return the equipment, the customer swipes the same card and the machine matches the last 4 numbers and re-opens/unlocks their spaces and they return everything.

The machine tells them if they have not closed the locker door or locked in the kayak properly and then computes how long they have had them out and up-charges if necessary.

You can get either 4, 8 or 12 lockers and kayak racks. It is modular, so if you buy 4 and it's too small, then you can add another set to the original. We recommend a max of 12 at each location, so there are not people waiting to rent and return, then put another unit near by.

NOTE: Kayak Kiosks are producing greater than 100% ROI (Return on Investment) in one season.



KAYAK KIOSK FAQ'S

HOW MANY CAN I GET?

4, 8 or 12 lockers and kayak racks. It is modular, so you can add another set to the original if it is too small.

HOW BIG IS EACH UNIT?

Each locker is 5 feet wide and 4 feet deep. The kayak racks are 4ft x 4 ft. The lockers are approximately 15 inches wide and 2 ft deep.

HOW STURDY IS THE MACHINE?

The machine is all steel construction and is very sturdy. The feet have holes to either bolt into asphalt or cement, or we send along rebar with bolts welded on one end so you can pound them into the ground if it's on dirt.

HOW DO THE MACHINES WORK?

We have a 4G secure and encrypted telemetry system that finds the strongest cell signal in the area. We also have solar powered systems where electrical outlets are unavailable. For solar, the charge controller, battery harness, solar panel with mount, come with the machine. Batteries are sent separately. Customer is responsible for purchasing a 10ft 1.5in OD pole, which can be found at stores from the electrical aisle like Lowes.

HOW MUCH DO THE KAYAK KIOSKS COST?

This is a modular system. The pricing is as follows:



REMOTE OPERATION? You can take control of the machine to open doors, manually return equipment or troubleshoot. Sometimes people accidentally shut the doors before they get all their gear out, or after returning, leave their car keys and/or wallet in the lockers. To combat this we added a secondary router so that the owner/operator can remotely take control of the machines from their computer or smart phone and reopen lockers, unlock kayaks or manually return forgotten items. All the customer has to do is call your customer service line and you help them out quickly and efficiently.

HOW IS THE MACHINE SET UP?

It arrives on site assembled and palletized, and locker can be "dollied" around by one person and then the rack attached and the roof put on. once you have power...it is ready to vend. We have solar and AC unit or you can switch back and forth.

ARE THERE ANY FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE MACHINE?

There is no annual cost, markup, franchise or licensing fees. Swipe fees go directly to the POS company and they take it out of your sales weekly/monthly. For the on-board POS system, they charge 3% of the rental fee, plus 10 cents for each rental. It is \$9.95/month for the POS back-office access (this allows you to see sales and have preprogrammed reports for accounting and information purposes) and unlimited cellular airtime to complete sales.

HOW DO YOU GET A RECEIPT FOR THE RENTALS?

Email the address or text the number on the machine with the last four digits of the card you used and a receipt will be sent back to you.

The machine is programmed so that it will not vend between the hours of dusk and dawn to comply with safe boating regulations.
